Dear Parishioners,

There are certain Catholic feasts that have made their way into American culture: St. Patrick's Day, of course, is a day to celebrate Irish heritage; St. Valentine's Day is intended to honor a saint who was particularly devoted to performing marriages; on St. Nicholas' Day children find treats in their stockings; Halloween (Hallow's Eve) is the evening leading up to All Saints Day (or All Hallows Day).

With the plethora of saints in our Church, every day of the year is a feast of one saint or another, most of them going unnoticed. But it is a nice habit to celebrate those saints who have particular significance to each of us. I encourage all of us to find out the feast day for the saints associated with our baptismal or confirmation names, or to simply pick a saint with whom we feel a special connection, and to make a point of celebrating that day.

July 26 is one of those days which is important to those who live in and around Marienville. It is the feast of St. Ann, the patroness of our church in Marienville. In Catholic regions of the world, a church feast day is typically celebrated with a procession through the town and a large festival. It would be nice to see a large crowd come out to celebrate the feast of our church's patroness.

Rather, most abusers are known to the child, such as the parent, sibling, parent's paramour, parent's spouse, other relative or babysitter. One of the most important ways to ensure the safety of children in our environments is to know the warning signs of adults who present a risk of harm to children. Among these signs are when the person (1) always wants to be alone with children in areas where no one can monitor the interactions, (2) allows children to do things their parents would not permit, (3) is always more excited to be with children than with adults, and (4) discourages others from participating in activities involving kids. The ethical reception of COVID-19 vaccines


