Dear Parishioners,

A few things this week:

First, on Tuesday we will celebrate Independence Day. We commemorate the birth of our nation with flags and fireworks and franks, it is important that we also celebrate with our faith. Mass on Independence Day is at 8:30am. It is just a normal daily Mass, but we will sing a few patriotic hymns. Mass is a great way to kick-off the Fourth of July. I look forward to seeing you there.


