From the Desk of Father James



Dear Parishioners,

Next Sunday is the Feast of Corpus Christi. On Corpus Christi we honor the greatest gift that Jesus has given to his Church: the Eucharist. The Eucharist is the very Body and Blood of our Lord, made present at every Mass and reserved in the Tabernacle. This is a gift that we take for granted far too often. St. John Vianney summarizes the Eucharist simply when he says: "If we really understood the Mass, we would die of joy." Too often, however, the Mass can become overly familiar and we can fail to recognize how it is so amazing that the Lord of Heaven and Earth becomes present for us upon the altar.

The Feast of Corpus Christi is an opportunity for us to refocus our attention more acutely on this greatest sacrament. **Our parish will be celebrating Corpus Christi with a Eucharistic Procession at the 8:30 a.m. Mass.** Weather permitting, our Eucharistic Procession will leave the church, go around the cemetery, and back into the church. The procession is then followed by Eucharistic Benediction. I encourage all to be present at this Mass and participate in this procession. Last year we had a Eucharistic Procession on our Diocesan Eucharistic Day in October and it was a great success. Let us all pray for good weather so that we can have another beautiful celebration in which we honor the Lord in the Blessed Sacrament.

Child Protection and Creating Safe Environments- National CyberTipline: The National Center for Missing and Exploited Children's CyberTipline is the nation's centralized reporting system for the online exploitation of children. Anyone can make reports of suspected online enticement of children for sexual acts, molestation, child pornography, child sex tourism, child sex trafficking (includes prostitution), child sextortion and unsolicited obscene materials sent to a child. Misleading domain names, misleading words or digital images on the internet can also be reported to the CyberTipline. NCMEC staff review each tip and work to find a potential location for the incident reported so that it may be made available to the appropriate law-enforcement agency for possible investigation. NCMEC provides resources/help in removing an online image. Reports can be made 24 hours a day, seven days a week online at www.cybertipline.org or by calling (800) 843-5678.
