There will also be a Chinese Auction, Bake Sale, Used Book and Puzzle Sale, Spring Raffle, and 50/50 Raffle.

CRAFTER/VENDOR RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- If you are a first-time participant for our craft shows, please enclose photos of your items.
- All applications and fees are due by March 15, 2024. However, the show may fill up prior to that date.
 Fees are non-refundable. Notification of acceptance will be via email, text, or phone call. Please make sure these are accurate on the application.
 - Crafters are to send in their payment with their application. Spots will not be reserved until payment is received. Vendors, see next bullet.
- Only one (1) vendor per company will be accepted (Thirty-one, Tupperware, etc.). Our church
 parishioners have the first opportunity to participate in this show. Vendors please do not send in
 your application fee until you have been accepted.
- If you have special needs, please let us know, and we will do what we can to accommodate you.
- To maintain the integrity of our show, we ask that all items for sale are handcrafted, homemade, or products from a vendor company. Prohibited items: illegal/dangerous weapons (knives, guns, etc.), alcoholic beverages, used/flea market items, material offensive to the public/Christian morality, and/or items that shoot a flying projectile.
- An 8 foot table/space is \$25.00 each limit 2 per crafter/vendor. **All items must be contained** within or on your 8 foot table/space. Displaying items in the walkway is not permitted. Please plan accordingly and consider building your display up.
- Outside vendors must supply their own tents/canopies and tables. One 12x12 space is \$30 and two 12 x 12 spaces is \$50
- Electricity is available on a limited basis, and is not guaranteed. Please make sure you mark this on the application and bring your own extension cords.
- A donation to the Chinese Auction is NOT required.
- Booth spaces/tables will be assigned. Crafters/Vendors shall not trade, share, or move into any other space which has not been assigned to them without permission of the committee.
- Set up is available Friday, April 26th from 4:00 7:00 p.m. or Saturday, April 27th at 7:30 a.m.
- Displays must be complete, attended, and open during all show hours. Booths must be neat and attractive. All boxes and materials must be kept from sight. You are responsible for your own table covering and skirting and for the clean-up of your area after the event by removing all trash and unsold items. All materials must be removed on Saturday, April 27, 2024, at the conclusion of the show.
